## **FAQs**

What is an Escape Room? An escape room is basically a series of live interactive puzzles that you solve as a group within the allotted time. You find items, discover clues, and solve puzzles. Each leads to a new clue which, when combined with other clues, gets you closer to your final passcode to escape the room.

Will I actually be locked in? No. You may leave at any time, but that won't actually count as "escaping" the room. Restrooms are available. The room has lights and windows and does not feel claustrophobic.

**Is it scary?** No. Your adrenaline might get pumping as you solve clues and find combinations, but nothing is scary.

**Do I need to be Lutheran?** No. The room is themed in honor of the 500<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Reformation, but no specific "Lutheran" knowledge is required.

**Can I bring my kids?** Probably not a good idea. The puzzles are designed for older teens and adults. Nothing will hurt your children, but they'll also be bored and possibly distract you from your puzzle solving!

Where is this room? Upstairs in Trinity's Yerger Building. There is a flight of stairs to reach the room. However, bathrooms are available on the same floor.

What is an appropriate donation? Commercial escape rooms charge approximately \$25/person. We are recommending between \$25-\$50 per group. All donations go to our social ministry/hunger work in the community.
