**This is My Story is** the theme of our 2020 Southeastern Pennsylvania Synodical Women of the ELCA convention. Our convention will be held **June 6, 2020** at **St. Matthew's Lutheran church, address:** 400 Lynbrooke Rd, Springfield, PA

19064. We will be celebrating 50 years of Ordination of Women Pastors of the Lutheran Church. In order to honor them, we are inviting all the active women pastors in our synod to join us for the day's event. Our scripture is from I Corinthians 4-6: *"There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. 5 There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. 6 There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.*

In addition to our keynote speaker, two of our women pastors will share their experiences. We selected one ordained pastor with over 15 years of experience and one ordained pastor with less than 5 years of experience. # 2019 Fall Conference Gatherings Upper Bucks

On Saturday, November 2, 2019 Women of Peace-Tohickon Lutheran church, Perkasie welcomed women from churches in the ELCA PA synod to the Upper Bucks WELCA Fall Gathering for breakfast, fellowship, devotions and program. The theme was "Being Family" and program led by Jennifer Hind informed us about services for women who are involved in domestic violence.

She said domestic violence is NOT rare; abuse doesn't have to be physical; the effects of emotional abuse are just as damaging as those of physical and sexual abuse. Men are also victims of domestic abuse as are teens and seniors. Women's Place's telephone hot line, **800-220-8116** is always answered, 24/7. Counselors are available to help, and they are both compassionate and knowledgeable.

The offering was split between Women of the ELCA and A Woman's Place. The women and their churches also donated bras and underwear for women in A Women's Place. Those coming from the hospital frequently have no clothes as their clothes are being held by the police for evidence.

# **Upper Montgomery**

On Saturday, October 26, 2019 Women of Augustus Lutheran Church, Trappe welcomed 19 women from 7 churches to the Upper Montgomery WELCA gathering. The program was on "Being Family" using Proverbs 22:6. The Reverend Dr. Martha Kriebel, currently on staff at Augustus Lutheran Church in Trappe and serving as an Honorary Assistant, gave a power point presentation about "Who are today's children – Gen Z (1995 to 2015), Millennial (1980 to 1994), Gen X (1965 to 1979), and Baby Boomer (1944 to 1964). She also included a message from Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton, "God loves everyone to the end". Refreshments were shared by the women.
