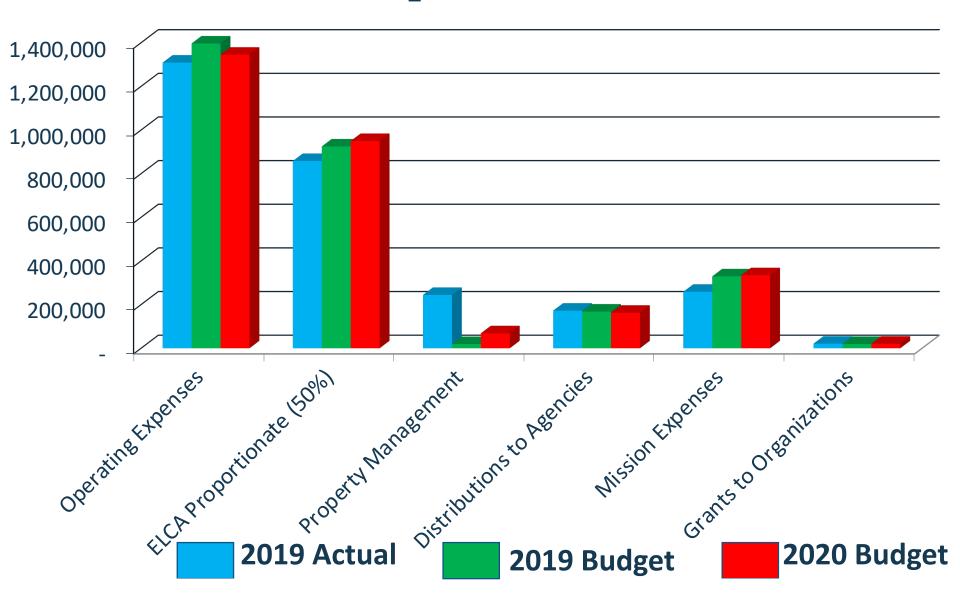

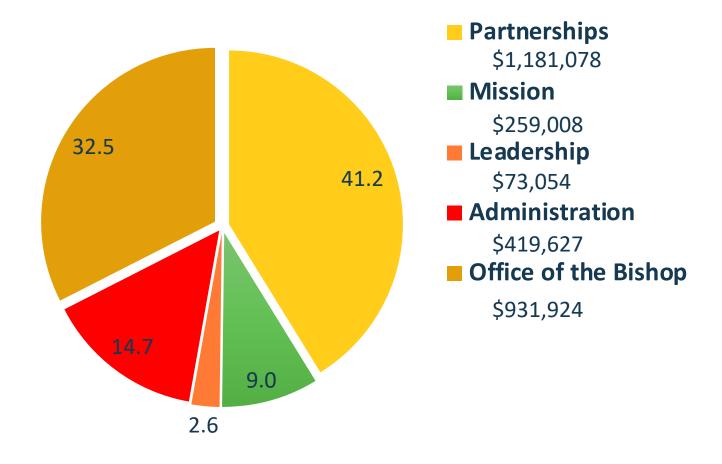
as a % of congregational regular giving in 2019

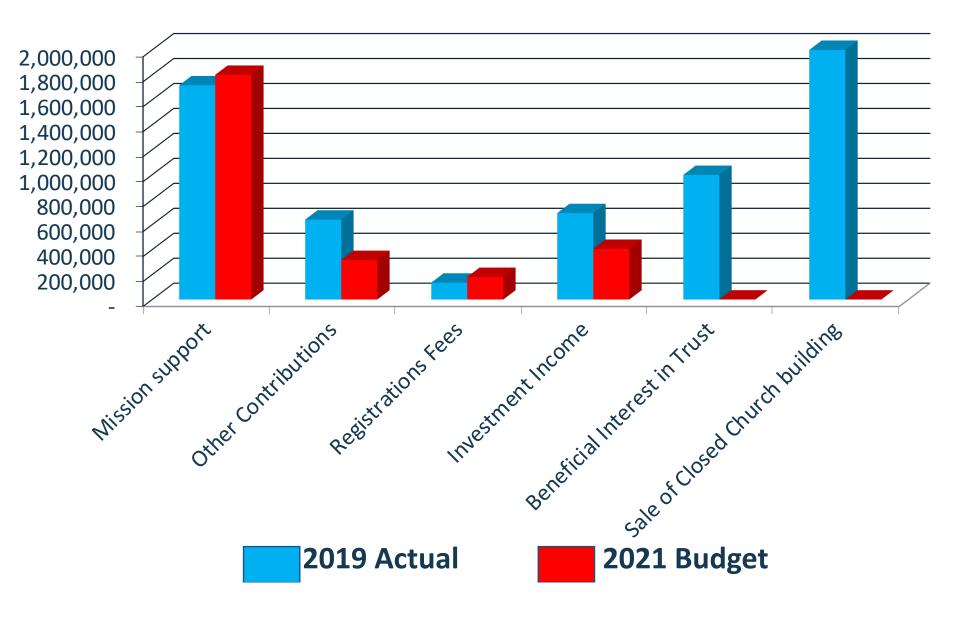

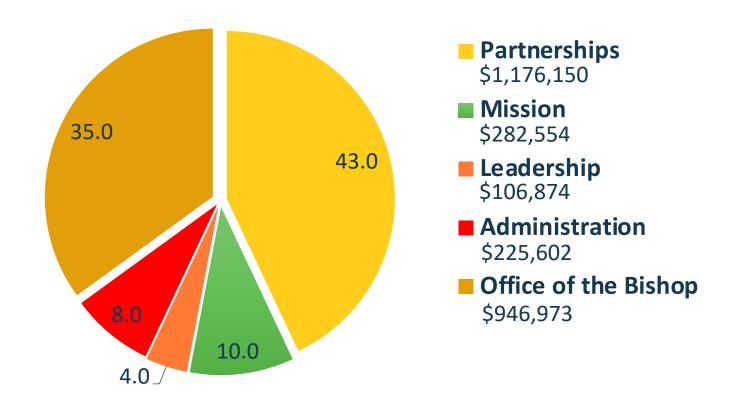
