Habitat and Thrivent Faith Builds Process

Faith Builds depends on a community coming together to make a difference in the lives of a local family. Here's how you and your church can get involved.



Multiple churches and Christian organizations partner together with Habitat and Thrivent

The local Christian community comes together to raise walls, funds and prayers to build a house in partnership with a family in your community. Faith Builds is a concrete way to put your faith into action and see tangible results.

As a part of Faith Builds, your church or organization commits to:

- Help financially with the build through the Generosity Challenge (see next step).
- Generously donate volunteer time, helping with construction and nonconstruction activities.
- Pray for the community and homeowner family.

But that's just the beginning. Faith Builds also:

- Builds community within your church.
- Empowers church members to serve in the community.
- Gives people of faith an opportunity to engage in construction and nonconstruction activities and be the body of Christ in the world.
- Helps build community among Christian churches.
