I am a skilled administrator, having honed my skills for leadership and service over a long career that has been spent in many leadership contexts. I am passionate for a church that serves its community showing in concrete ways what the love of Christ looks like in relationship to the world that God loves. I am also passionate about engaging the church in deeper connection to the mission of Jesus Christ in the world and serving those in need.

So much has been written about the decline of the church, and there is much data that can lead us to despair over that. There is a lot of fear in our churches that seems to hamper our ability to move forward into whatever this new era of the church will look like. Six years from now, we will look different than we do today, but we must trust that God can guide this transformation into something that will enrich the Kingdom of God.

We are a people of resurrection. We confess this in our creeds and witness this in our worship. We understand that here is suffering and grief in the world, but we worship a God that has power over death; a God that is a God of the living, and a God that can do what we think is impossible; a God that is always bigger than we can imagine. I pray that the Spirit would empower me to witness to that God of promise in those situations where we are afraid to embrace an uncertain future, a future that rests in the loving hands of God.

Over a long and diverse career, I have learned to adapt my leadership style to fit the needs of many different contexts. I have had the privilege to direct large staffs where team-building and empowerment were critical to working together to achieve goals. I seek collaboration and consensus wherever possible, but also understand when it is important to be decisive so we can move forward together. As a pastor, I lead staff, volunteers and community members with a focus on mission, cultivating a spirit of generosity in our approach to interacting with the world and with each other. I fully believe and stand fast on the principle that we serve a God of abundance - a God that does not want us to be fearful and protective, but to love and serve generously, reflecting the grace that God has shown us.
