The holy gospel according to John. Glory to you, O Lord.
${ }^{9}$ "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. ${ }^{10}$ If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. ${ }^{11}$ I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. ${ }^{12}$ My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ${ }^{13}$ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. ${ }^{14}$ You are my friends if you do what I command. ${ }^{15}$ I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business.
